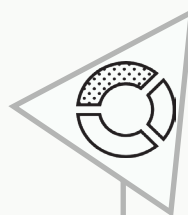

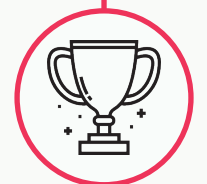

Took part in a mentoring session with Manager at Department of Education International.



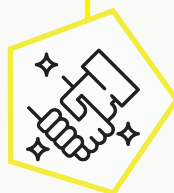
AUG 2018
